1. Introduction

Malti Dhari College, Naubatpur, Patna (affiliated with Patliputra University, Patna) organized “**Vande Mataram Week**” from **7th November 2025 to 14th November 2025** on the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the national song “*Vande Mataram*.” This multi-day event was conducted under the joint aegis of NCC & NSS units, various academic departments, and the Cultural Committee.

3. Day-wise Programme Details

7th November 2025 (Friday) – Inauguration of Vande Mataram Week

The program commenced at **10:00 AM** at the Bapu Ethical Ground with a ceremonial lamp lighting, creating an inspiring and solemn atmosphere. This was followed by flag hoisting and collective singing of “*Vande Mataram*.”

Principal Dr. Akhilesh Kumar stated that “*Vande Mataram is not just a song, but a symbol of India’s soul, struggle, and unity. Events like these develop a sense of responsibility and understanding of constitutional values among students.*”

Dr. Sweta Bala, NCC Coordinator and NAAC/IQAC Coordinator, presented the outline of the week-long activities and encouraged active participation from students.

8th November 2025 (Saturday) – Essay Competition: “Vande Mataram and the Indian Freedom Struggle”

Organized jointly by the Hindi and English departments, the competition began with lamp lighting. The judging panel evaluated entries based on language, content, originality, and presentation.

10th November 2025 (Monday) – Poster & Painting Competition and Short Film/Documentary Screening

Organized by the Art Department and Cultural Committee, the event began with lamp lighting. Students expressed national sentiment creatively, while the Mass Communication Department showcased documentaries connecting students to historical awareness.

11th November 2025 (Tuesday) – Exhibition: “History and Significance of Vande Mataram”

Organized by the History Department and Library Committee, the exhibition was inaugurated with lamp lighting. Educational models, charts, and rare photographs related to Anand Math, Sannyasi Rebellion, Swadeshi Movement, Non-Cooperation Movement, Salt Satyagraha, and Quit India Movement were displayed.

12th November 2025 (Wednesday) – Debate Competition: “National Pride and the Modern Relevance of Vande Mataram”

Organized by the Political Science Department, the competition began with lamp lighting. Students presented logical, expressive, and thought-provoking arguments.

13th November 2025 (Thursday) – Cultural Evening: Patriotic Songs, Dance-Drama & Vande Mataram Concert

The program began with lamp lighting and collective singing. Student performances filled the atmosphere with patriotism. Principal Dr. Akhilesh Kumar emphasized that such events strengthen students’ national identity and cultural consciousness.

14th November 2025 (Friday) – Closing Ceremony & Prize Distribution of Vande Mataram
